Nancy J. Mohns, 86, of Rockton went to be with her Heavenly Father on Friday, April 19, 2024. Born September 22, 1937 in Belvidere; daughter of Wilson and Faye (Eis) Cain. 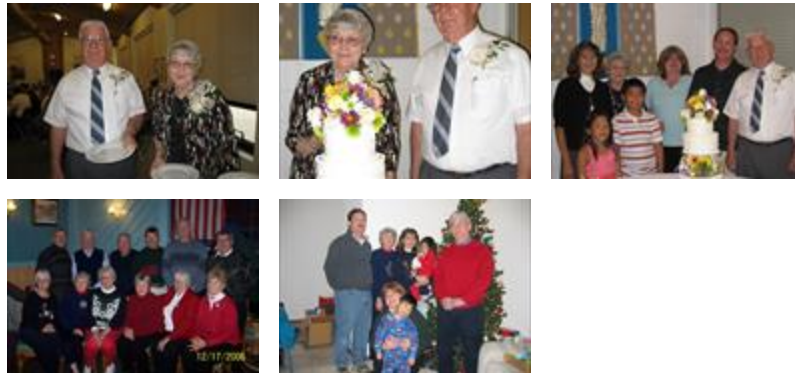
